

Starbuntu - Quick Start Guide

Change Design:

- Background: App Menu / Graphics / Background or Ctrl+Super+w
- Themes: (windows, icons): App Menu / Preferences / Appearance

App Menu Management:

- Left click on the first panel button, navigate to the entry, click on the cursor bar under 'Parameters', enter parameters, 'OK'
- Change menu entry: Ctrl+Super+d, enter keyword, select desktop file, edit
- Delete menu entry: Ctrl+Super+d, enter keyword, select desktop file, 'NoDisplay=true' in the last field
- Add menu entry: Ctrl+Super+d, no keyword, 'OK', desktop file name, 'OK', edit file
- Change structure: right click on the first bar button, enter password, follow program instructions
- After all changes, left click on the second bar button, then click on the Starbuntu logo, otherwise the app menu will only be updated in the next session. This also applies to package changes.

Panel Management:

- Call assignment of the bar buttons: Mouse pointer on button, then: call left | (middle |) right assignment with left | (middle |) right mouse button
- Change assignment: Left click on the field before the system tray, choose button, 'OK', edit, 'OK'

Find Menu Entry:

- Middle click on the corresponding menu button (App Menu, Memo Menu, File and Url exposition), then keyword in the text input box, 'OK'

Change System Tray:

- Add a program temporarily: Right click on the field before the system tray
- Retain added program: Right-click on symbol, then click on '→ Permanent'
- Remove permanence: Right click on icon, then click on 'Quit permanent'
- Remove the program temporarily: right-click on the symbol, then click on 'Quit'
- Performing the last two steps will remove the program definitely.

Trash Bin Management:

- Delete object(s) reversibly: right click, then click on '_ To Trash'
- Restore object(s): right click, then click on '_ Restore From Trash'
- Empty Trash: Right-click on an object, then click on 'Empty Trash Bin'

Open a file with its application:

- In the file manager: click on the file
- Command input: in the terminal 'all-open file path' (or 'a file path' for short), in the command input box the file path is sufficient

Open a file with a different application:

- In the file manager: select file, F11, enter 'Application "\$@"' in the lower text field, Return
- Command input: in the terminal/command input box 'application file path'

Run desktop file with parameters:

- In the file manager: Mark the file, F11, enter 'x "\$@" parameters' in the lower text field, Return
- Command input: in the terminal / in the command input box 'exec-desktop filename parameters' (or 'x filename parameters' for short)
- In the App Menu: see above.

Change User:

- If a white window appears briefly after starting a program, press Super and enter your password.
- Open object as another user: right click, click on '→ Other User', enter your own password (for root rights) or the password of the other user and in this case select this user under 'User' (for rights of this user)
- Command input: 'gsu command' (see previous point for details)

Edit Memo Menu, File Exposition, Url Exposition:

- Memo Menu: Mark the text passage to be added, Ctrl+Super+n, set title, select category, 'OK'
Edit memo: Double click, then edit, 'OK'
Delete memo: Double click, then 'Del'
Add memo: 'Edit', then 'New', fill label and detail, 'OK'
- File Exposition: Right click on the file to be exposed, Open with..., 'Expose File', then set icon, application and category
Edit File Exp.: 'Edit', then edit fields, 'OK'
Delete File Exp.: 'Edit', then 'Del'
Add File Exp.: 'Edit', then 'New', fill label and detail, 'OK'
- Url Exposition: In the web browser Ctrl+Super+u, 'Yes', then set icon, application, category and title
Edit, delete, add url: see File Exposition

Most important keyboard and mouse shortcuts:

Meaning of the briefly appearing white window:
Pressing the Super key at the same time changes the effect (see shortcut keys)

0-9	in Rox: Call Group 0-9 (Groups after Ctrl+Super+o editable)
Ctrl+Alt+b	Bookmarks (in Rox Ctrl+b)
Ctrl+Alt+d	(1, 2,...) Open storage device 1, 2,...
Ctrl+Alt+o	External Sources (remote folders / file systems)
Ctrl+AltGr+Menu	Recently Used (without filter)
Ctrl+Menu	Recently Used (with filter)
Ctrl+Delete	Delete marked object(s) definitely
Ctrl+Super+o	Marked folders (call / edit Rox Groups or temporary bookmarks)
Super+o	in Rox: Add current folder to the marked folders
Ctrl+Super+p	Open trash bin
Shift+Delete	Marked object(s) to trash bin

System Administration:

Alt+F2	Open command input box (+Super: as root)
Alt+F3	Open terminal (+Super: as root)
Ctrl+Alt+p	Package manager
Ctrl+Alt+u	Upgrade program

Window And Program Management:

Alt+F4	Terminate GUI program
Right-click on window icon	Terminate GUI program
Mouse gesture < in program	Terminate GUI program
Alt+F9	Minimize window
Left-click on window icon	Minimize / normalize window
F11	Maximize / normalize window
Middle click on window icon	Maximize / normalize window
Ctrl+F4	Close Tab
Ctrl+Alt+f	Search GUI app
Ctrl+Alt+k	Keyboard and mouse shortcuts
Ctrl+Super+k	Control Center
Menu	App Menu Starbuntu (with parameter input)
AltGr+Menu	App Menu Openbox

Ctrl+Shift+x	Cut to secondary clipboard
Ctrl-Super+Ins	Paste secondary clipboard entry
Ctrl+Super+c	Copy to clipboard
Ctrl+Super+x	Cut to clipboard
Ctrl+v (Super+v)	Paste (historicized) clipboard entry

Interrupt / terminate session:

Alt+Pause	Hibernate session (Suspend to disc)
Desktop: mouse gesture h	Hibernate session (Suspend to disc)
Ctrl+Alt+Delete	Pause / terminate session
Ctrl+Alt+Esc	Log out
Desktop: mouse gesture L	Log out
Ctrl+Alt+q	Shut down
Desktop: mouse gesture V	Shut down
Ctrl+Alt+w	Reboot
Desktop: mouse gesture Λ	Reboot
Ctrl+BackSpace	Cancel Terminate session (within 5 seconds)
Pause	Pause (Suspend to RAM)
Desktop: mouse gesture —	Pause (Suspend to RAM)
Shift+Pause	Lock screen (Unlock: Password+Return)
Mouse gesture >	Lock screen (Unlock: Password+Return)
